## Dear Families,

Beginning this week we will highlight 2 words of the week, much like we have done all year with letters of the week. After the first of the year students will be responsible for spelling these words correctly. The goal is that all students will be able to fluently read AND write all 30 kindergarten words. This week's words are you and me. We are also focusing on vowel sounds - which tend to be very tricky for 5 and 6 year olds. Students know that vowels make 2 sounds (long and short).

Don't forget that Scholastic book orders are due to me by Wednesday, December 4th. This will guarantee delivery by Christmas break. If you wish to order and use the books as a gift, just let me know and I will make arrangements for you to pick them up in the office. Our Scholastic class code is L7LXF.

I will try to keep the holiday activities contained and focused on learning for as long as I can.
